CHAPLAIN'S CORNER

Greeting Comrades.

As we consider the unprecedented times our state and nation are now going through, the thought that comes to mind is James 1:8 "... a double minded man [woman] is unstable in all his [her] ways.." This was written by James, the family member brother of Christ. The context of the passage has to do with a continuing ongoing relationship in Jesus while praying and asking God for wisdom under times of extreme pressure or extraordinarily difficult times. The phrase "double minded" really does not have anything to do with a mental health condition, it actually has to do more with an attitude.

Essentially James is talking about the "divided loyalty" some Christians experience under times of undue cultural stress. James is encouraging his readers to stay with Christ, while pointing out some of the misunderstandings his readers have about God through their ongoing struggle. James does not make light of the circumstances and challenging times they are living, but he is emphasizing a plea for a vital relationship with Christ.
