



CHAPLAIN'S CORNER

This month we will take a break from our discussion in The Book of Ephesians. Next month we will look into the third myth (misunderstanding) about grace. The best illustration of this misunderstanding can be seen in The Parable of The Lost Son (Luke 15:11-32), in other words there are two totally opposite human responses to God's grace. The one son who lives wildly, displays the myth we wrote about last month (God's grace is for us to enjoy anyway we want). The second son who obeys his father in all things, displays the third myth about God's grace i.e. grace and good works are opposed to one another. The two sons have both missed the true meaning of the relationship their father wants with them by the way they lived. Consequently this month we would like to share with you a psalm of understanding, guidance, and protection.

Psalm 25, New Living Translation of The Holy Bible.

A psalm of David.

¹O LORD, I give my life to you. ²I trust in you, my God! Do not let me be disgraced, or let my enemies rejoice in my defeat. ³No one who trusts in you will ever be disgraced, but disgrace comes to those who try to deceive others. ⁴Show me the right path, O LORD; point out the road for me to follow. ⁵Lead me by your truth and teach me, for you are the God who saves me. All day long I put my hope in you. ⁶Remember, O LORD, your compassion and unfailing love, which you have shown from long ages past. ⁷Do not remember the rebellious sins of my youth. Remember me in the light of your unfailing love, for you are merciful, O LORD. ⁸The LORD is good and does what is right; he shows the proper path to those who go astray. ⁹He leads the humble in doing right, teaching them his way. ¹⁰The LORD leads with unfailing love and faithfulness all who keep his covenant and obey his demands. ¹¹For the honor of your name, O LORD, forgive my many, many sins. ¹²Who are those who fear the LORD? He will show them the path they should choose. ¹³They will live in prosperity, and their children will inherit the land. ¹⁴The LORD is a friend to those who fear him. He teaches them his covenant. ¹⁵My eyes are always on the LORD, for he rescues me from the traps of my enemies. ¹⁶Turn to me and have mercy, for I am alone and in deep distress. ¹⁷My problems go from bad to worse. Oh, save me from them all! ¹⁸Feel my pain and see my trouble. Forgive all my sins. ¹⁹See how many enemies I have and how viciously they hate me! ²⁰Protect me! Rescue my life from them! Do not let me be disgraced, for in you I take refuge. ²¹May integrity and honesty protect me, for I put my hope in you. ²²O God, ransom Israel [and the United States of America] from all its troubles.



VA: SWITCH FROM DS LOGON TO LOGIN.GOV OR ID.ME BY SEPTEMBER 30

After Sept. 30, 2025, Veterans will have two secure options to sign in to VA.gov and VA mobile apps—a Login.gov account or ID.me account. Most Veterans have already made the switch. If you're still using a DS Logon username and password, we want to make sure you're prepared when this option is discontinued by the end of September.

How to Transition

1. Visit [Creating an account for VA.gov](#) for detailed instructions on setting up your Login.gov or ID.me account.
2. Follow the step-by-step guide to create your account and verify your identity.
3. Use your new account to access VA services online as you did before.


