

#### **VETS ON THE HILL**

As was mentioned in last month's newsletter, the Veterans on the Hill day will be March 12th this year. We are still working out the schedule for the bus stops to pick up veterans and spouses on the way down to the Capitol from our area up here. We are encouraging all veterans and their spouses to attend if possible. There is no requirement that they belong to any Military Organization, so spread the word to any Veteran friends that you know and invite them to go along. Remember, there isn't any charge for the trip and there will be beverages, snacks, and a meal provided.

There are a couple of things we ask;

We all survived Christmas as far as I know. I pray that you were able to enjoy time with family and friends. As we move on to the New Year, what can we do differently? Many of us get stuck in our ways and lose the ability to try something new. How can we make the year 2018 our best ever? What are your New Year resolutions? I have met many new veterans in the last year. How might we make this world better for those who were willing to sacrifice their very lives to maintain our freedom? This is what the DAV is all about. Working together we help those who have fallen in one way or another along the way.

As I serve alongside of my comrades, I learn from each of you. We all have a story to tell. I have heard heart breaking stories of soldier's men and women doing terrible things to each other. The world can be a cold dark place for those whose wounds we might not be able to see. How do we help these soldiers? They might seem a little crazy or dirty or even homeless. Perhaps their families have given up on them? The problem with many Vietnam vets especially is that they need our help. We need to give them more than money. 
